
**To:** Heads of Bureaus and Offices  
**From:** Director, Office of Environmental Policy and Compliance  
**Subject:** Numbers of Review Copies of Environmental Statements  
Required by Other Federal and Federal-State Agencies

To the maximum extent practicable bureaus and offices should endeavor to distribute sufficient numbers of copies of environmental statements to other Federal and Federal-State agencies for review purposes.

Generally, two review copies of environmental statements should be distributed to the established contact point in each reviewing agency for each major subordinate element which is expected to review the statement, unless it is known that one copy will suffice.

Some Federal agencies have informed the Department of their need for additional review copies of environmental statements. A list of these agencies and their requirements is attached.

This memorandum replaces ES74-5.
